

# Informed Consent Form

Sample informed consent document — reviewed with the study team at screening.

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## **Introduction**

You are being invited to take part in a research study. This document explains the study so you can decide whether you would like to participate. Please read it carefully and ask the study team any questions you have before signing.

## **Purpose of the study**

The purpose of this study is to evaluate the safety, tolerability, and efficacy of an investigational therapy in adults with advanced NSCLC whose disease has progressed following prior treatment.

## **Study procedures**

If you agree to take part, you will undergo a screening evaluation, be assigned to a treatment group, and attend scheduled study visits. Procedures include blood draws, imaging (CT or MRI), electrocardiograms, and symptom assessments. A complete schedule of assessments is included in Appendix A.

## **Possible risks and benefits**

As with any clinical trial, there may be risks that are known, expected, or not yet identified. The study team will discuss all known risks and potential side effects with you. While the investigational therapy may provide benefit, no benefit is guaranteed. Your participation contributes to medical knowledge that may help others with NSCLC in the future.

## **Confidentiality**

Your personal information will be kept confidential to the extent permitted by law. Study records will be stored securely and identified by a code rather than your name whenever possible. The sponsor, regulatory authorities, and the independent review board may review study records as part of their oversight duties.

## **Your rights**

Participation is voluntary. You may withdraw consent at any time, for any reason, and this will not affect your future care. You will be informed of any new findings during the study that could influence your decision to continue.
